<u>Item #4– Clover Street School Restrooms ADA Improvements Phase 2– 9552 CIP</u> FY2024

According to Brittany Clark, the project is progressing nicely and things are ahead of schedule. Abatement is complete. The work on cold framing and plumbing is in progress.

Item #7 -- LP Wilson HVAC Improvements Phase 2B - 9551 CIP FY2025

According to Brittany Clark, McKinney Construction has removed all the furniture, so abatement can begin. State approval was received to start the abatement process. Haz-Pros put up the poly, in preparation for the abatement. Hard barriers are going up on the BOE side of the building. The schedule is on track, despite the delay on abatement. On the gym side, some issues have been worked through with the fire marshal and architect concerning some sprinkler heads that needed relocating. Work is scheduled to start on August 17th, after the summer camps are over. The project is currently on schedule.
