<u>Item #4– Clover Street School Restrooms ADA Improvements Phase 2– 9552 CIP FY2024</u>

Per Brittany Clark project is progressing nicely. Some of the pods have sheet rock going up and framing being finished. Other pods are backfilling the piping the plumbing. The electrical inspections are ongoing and all passing. They are on schedule, if not ahead of schedule. The contractor is doing a great job.

Motion: Commissioner Jim Bennett moved to accept application 3 from 7 Summits Construction, LLC., dated 7/7/25 for Clover Street School Restrooms ADA Improvements Phase 2 in the amount of \$12,480.00. Seconded by Commissioner Rusty Peck.

Item #5 -- LP Wilson HVAC Improvements Phase 1 - 9551 CIP FY2023

According to Marco Aglieco Trane, Automated Logic, and Action Air will be on site tomorrow morning. Hopefully they can get the DOAS unit issues resolved.

Item #6 -- LP Wilson HVAC Improvements Phase 2 - 9551 CIP FY2023

Marco Aglieco reported units are operating minor adjustments are needed. Some punch list items are being addressed by Action Air for resolution.

<u>Item #7 -- LP Wilson HVAC Improvements Phase 2B - 9551 CIP FY2025</u>

According to Brittany Clark, they are finishing up the abatement in the core test testing area. After it is complete, they will start work on the flooring in that area. The goal is to be finished by the week of August 25. New grids and ceilings are up in the classrooms. Abatement continues in the outer areas (BOE). Aglieco On July 23 units will arrive. The gym work starts in August. Per Marco Aglieco a quote on the sprinkler head relocation should be available by the next meeting.

Motion: Commissioner Rusty Peck moved to approve application 1 from 7 Summits Construction, LLC dated 7/7/25 for LP Wilson HVAC Improvements Phase 2B CIP 9551 in the amount of \$9,984.00. Seconded by Commissioner Jim Bennett.

Item #8 - Wilson Fire Station Interior -- 9585 CIP FY2025

Per Marco Aglieco. he is still waiting on McKinney for a change order on painting. Controls have been ordered and need installation. The cameras will go up in the front, sides, and back of the building. This will also allow for card access. It was clarified that the cameras are both a replacement and an upgrade from the current ones.

Motion: Commissioner Rusty Peck moved to approve quote 28003 from Three-Way Communication, dated 4/16/25 for Wilson Fire Station Roof Interior CIP 9585 in the amount of \$11,710.00. Seconded by Commissioner Lee Alford.

Motion: Commissioner Lee Alford moved to approve quote 28007 from Three-Way Communication, dated 4/16/25 for Wilson Fire Station Roof Interior CIP 9585 in the amount of \$3,830.00. Seconded by Commissioner Rusty Peck.

Item #9 – Poquonock Elementary School Roof Design – 9558 CIP FY2024

Marco Aglieco reported that they are waiting on the Board of Education to motion to close out phase one. However, that was not accomplished at the last meeting and will have to wait until the fall. Then it can go to the state for grant consideration.

Item #10 - Clover Street School Roof Design -- 9549 CIP FY2022

Marco Aglieco stated they are still waiting on Tom Hibbard for some minor adjustments to the design. The grant can be applied for after the completion of said adjustments.

<u>Item #11 -- Sage Park School Roof Design Replacement Phase 2 -- 9541 CIP</u> <u>FY2024</u>

Marco Aglieco reported Silktown Roofing could not break the pricing out any further. The other companies Marco contacted for a quote never gave official ones because the price was higher than Silktown Roofing's original quote. Therefore, Marco recommends that we reach back out to Silktown Roofing so this issue can move forward.

<u>Item #12 -- Oliver Ellsworth Humidity Mitigation – 9574 CIP FY2024</u>

Marco Aglieco stated that this is the last Van Zelm invoice for administrative services. Specifically, the services involved the monitoring of the punch list items which are now complete. Marco is going to contact Action Air regarding outstanding invoices. Atlas Metal Works were on site today installing the ladder once that is invoiced, Marco hopes to close out the project.

Motion: Commissioner Jim Bennett to approve invoice 53378 from Van Zelm Engineers, dated 4/23/25 for Oliver Ellsworth Humidity Mitigation in the amount of \$12,500.00. Seconded by Commissioner Rusty Peck.

<u>Item #14 -- Aquatic Facilities Improvements Goslee & Welch Design- 9536 CIP</u> FY2022

Per Marco Aglieco after meeting with Brian McCuster, of Weston and Samson, a final punch list was put together. Additional items came up that can't be addressed until September 25th. There is standing water on the concrete that does not drain, which could be a warranty issue. Marco believes leveler will likely not be sufficient to fix the issue. Marco has tried to reach out to Jim Russo, retired Project Manager, for his opinion. In addition, the benches at both Goslee and Welch pools are rusting at the bases. It has not yet been determined if it is a defect in the product.
