POOL SAFETY

- Constant Supervision: Never leave children unattended near or in the pool. Designate a responsible adult as a "water watcher" who is solely focused on supervising swimmers and free from distractions like phones or conversations.
- Buddy System: Always swim with a buddy, even strong swimmers.
- Establish Pool Rules: Clearly communicate and enforce pool rules, including no running, no pushing, and no diving in unsafe areas.
- Teach Children to Swim: Enroll children in swimming lessons and encourage them to develop basic swimming and water safety skills.
- CPR Training: Ensure at least one adult in the household is certified in CPR and knows how to respond to emergencies.
